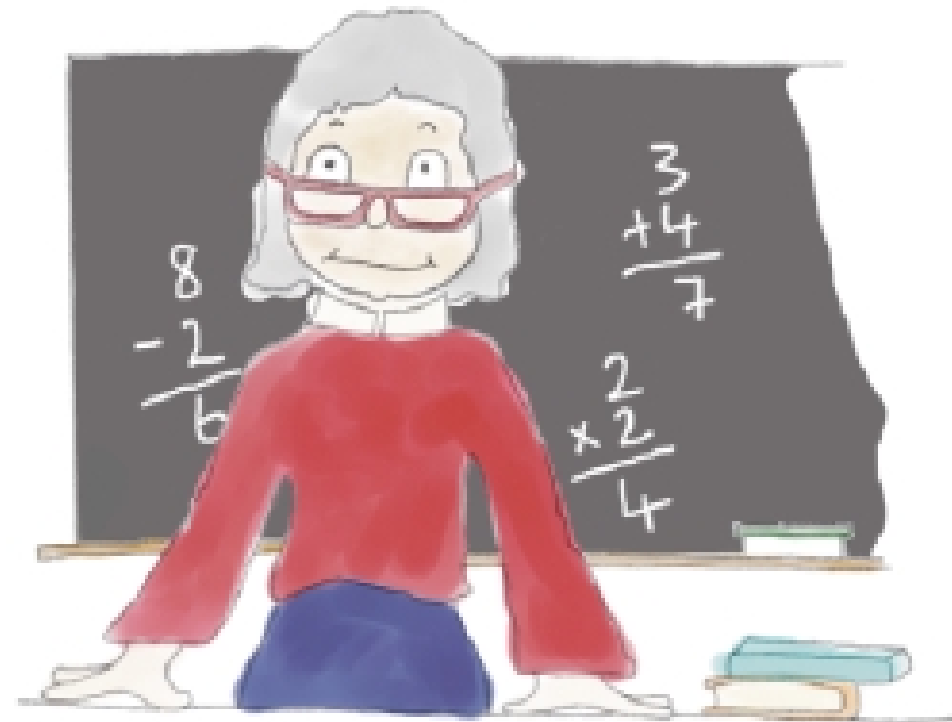
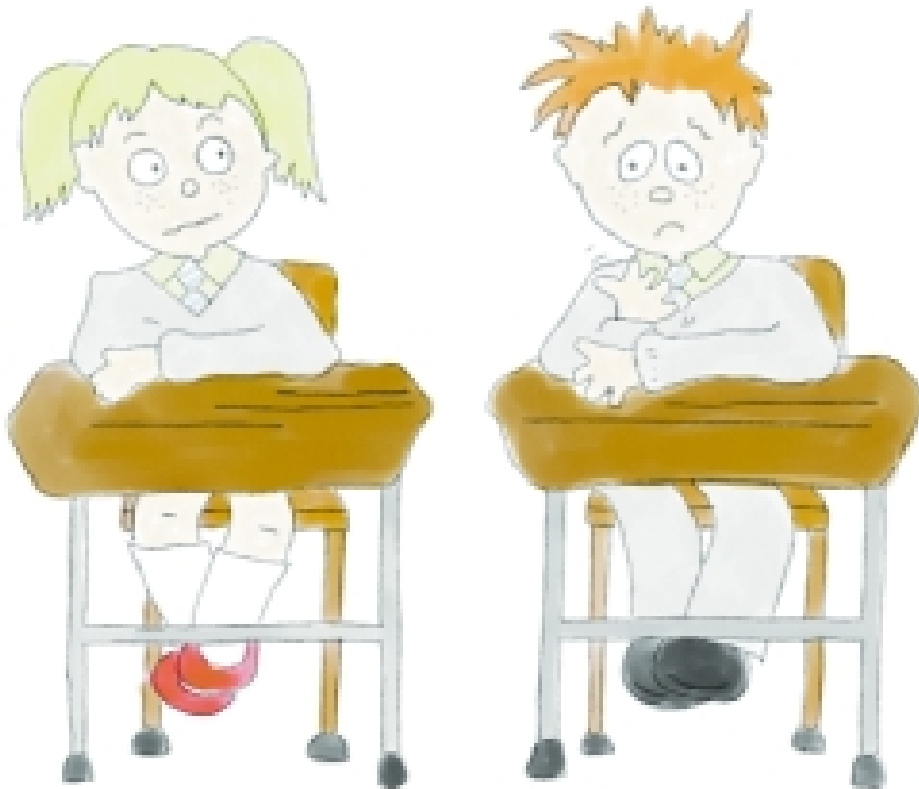


Eddie's Eczema

gets very dry”

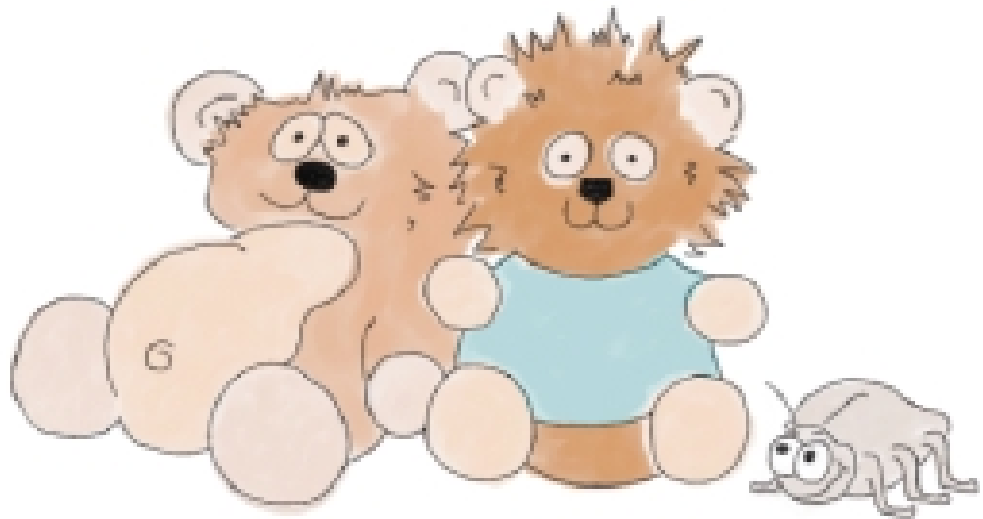
Wool is really scratchy



And if it gets infected it's awful.

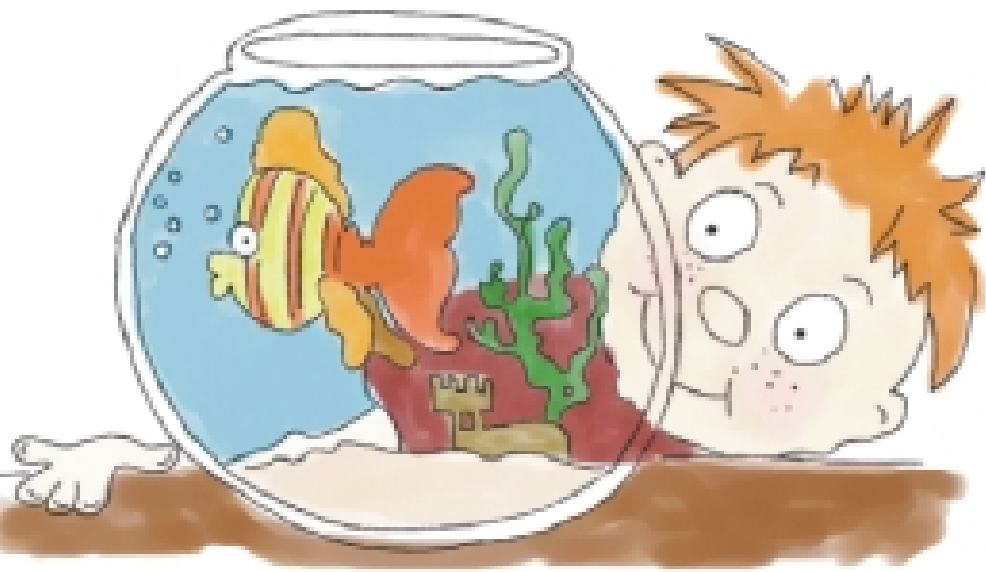


Mum and Dad have to be really careful not to kiss me if they have a cold sore, as that will make me even worse.

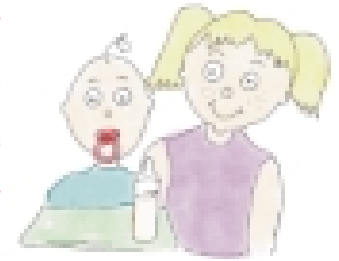


Also there is a baddie called "the house dust mite" and he lives in furry toys and dusty places.
